Special Meeting Summary – April 6, 2026

The Indian Valley Community Services District (IVCSD) Board of Directors held a special meeting on April 6, 2026, at the District office in Greenville, with one staff member attending via Zoom.

All Board members were present except Director Roger Cherry.

Key Action Item: Taylorsville Pool Agreement

The primary focus of the meeting was consideration of a Facility Use License Agreement between IVCSD and the Indian Valley Recreation and Parks District (IVRPD) for operation of the Taylorsville Pool.

Following a closed session discussion regarding negotiation terms, the Board returned to open session and took action to approve the agreement.

The agreement allows IVRPD to operate and manage public pool programming at the Taylorsville Pool during the summer season, including:

- Swim lessons
- Water aerobics
- Public swim and private events

Under the agreement:

- IVRPD will oversee pool operations, staffing, and programming
- IVRPD will be responsible for operational costs such as utilities, chemicals, and staffing
- IVCSD will retain ownership of the facility and responsibility for property-related costs
- The agreement term runs through the 2026 summer season

The Board approved the agreement unanimously (4–0, with one member absent).
