Regular Board Meeting – June 3, 2026

The Indian Valley Community Services District (IVCSD) Board of Directors met on June 3, 2026, to address ongoing infrastructure, financial, and recovery-related matters affecting the District and the broader Indian Valley community. All five Board members were present.

Investment and Financial Presentation

The Board received a presentation from Kris Kurpuweit of Edward Jones regarding investment and financial services opportunities. The Board also reviewed District financial information and approved the minutes from the May 20, 2026 Regular Board Meeting.

Banking and Administrative Updates

The Board approved corrections to resolution numbers adopted at the May 20 meeting regarding District bank signature cards and account administration, ensuring official records accurately reflect prior actions.

In addition, the Board voted to continue utilizing the District's existing Columbia Bank (formerly Umpqua Bank) accounts as its primary banking institution rather than establishing new accounts with another financial institution.

Secondary Water Source Committee Established

Recognizing the importance of long-term water reliability and future infrastructure planning, Board Chair Dan Kearns appointed Directors Andy Meyers and Roger Cherry to serve on a committee focused on evaluating secondary water source opportunities for the District.

Hazard Mitigation Support

The Board adopted Resolution 2026-011 supporting hazard mitigation efforts. The action is intended to strengthen the District's ability to pursue projects and planning initiatives that reduce risk from future natural disasters and improve community resilience.

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Dam Monitoring Discussion Deferred

The Board discussed potential improvements to dam recording and alarm systems but elected to postpone any decisions until District representatives can conduct a site visit with engineering consultants Wagner & Bonsignore to review system needs and options more thoroughly.

Dixie Fire Recovery Assistance Approved

A major action of the evening was the adoption of Ordinance 7.05.051 establishing a connection fee cap and inactive-rate eligibility program for properties destroyed by the Dixie Fire. The ordinance is intended to reduce financial barriers for property owners rebuilding within the District.

The Board also approved Resolution 2026-012 establishing inactive water and sewer service rates and defining eligibility requirements associated with the rebuild assistance program.

Greenville Park Use Decision

After considerable discussion regarding management and use of Greenville Park, the Board voted to allow the Indian Valley Recreation and Parks District (IVRPD) to reserve park facilities for future events through the District's reservation process rather than entering into a separate Facility Use Agreement. The motion passed on a 4-1 vote.

Cemetery Water Agreement Discussions

The Board approved sending a memorandum and letter of intent regarding a proposed long-term reservoir water agreement with the Greenville Cemetery District. The action supports continued discussions regarding future water supply opportunities and cooperative planning between the two agencies.

Safety Center Leadership Transition

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The Board accepted the resignation of Susan Doran as volunteer point of contact for the Public Safety Center project. The Board appointed Katherine Carpenter to serve as the new project point of contact moving forward.

Looking Ahead

The District continues advancing wildfire recovery efforts, water supply planning, infrastructure improvements, Public Safety Center development, and community rebuilding initiatives. Several actions taken during this meeting were aimed at supporting long-term resilience and strengthening services for residents throughout Indian Valley.

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
