Regular Board Meeting Summary - April 1, 2026

The Indian Valley Community Services District (IVCSD) Board of Directors held a regular meeting on April 1, 2026, at the District office in Greenville.

Meeting Overview

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Director Dan Kearns. Directors Wanda Carpenter, Andy Meyers, Dan Kearns, and Roger Cherry were present; Director Joshua Dunnington was absent. Staff in attendance included General Manager Jamie Little and administrative staff. The agenda and prior meeting minutes (March 10, March 18, and March 26) were approved.

Key Announcements

- The District announced a **\$15 million settlement with PG&E** (net after attorney fees), marking a significant milestone in wildfire recovery efforts.

Major Actions and Decisions

- **Fire Protection Grant Approved:** The Board adopted Resolution 2026-008, accepting a CAL FIRE 50/50 grant of approximately **\$9,627** to support fire protection capabilities.
- **HR Consulting Services:** Approved a contract with CPS HR Consulting (not to exceed \$5,000) to support the District's human resources needs.
- **Property Negotiations:** Approved Letters of Intent to begin negotiations with Plumas Rural Services regarding potential acquisition and development of properties on Hot Springs Road and Ayoob Alley.
- **ADA Accessibility Compliance:** Approved an agreement for website document accessibility services to improve compliance and public access to District materials.

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- **Professional Services Agreements:** Approved an agreement with Municipal Resource Group (MRG) for investigatory services (not to exceed \$22,750).

Discussion Items

- **Disaster Recovery Progress:** The Board received an update on ongoing recovery projects, including infrastructure planning, FEMA coordination, and efforts to secure reimbursement funding.
- **Water & Infrastructure Planning:** Discussion included water treatment funding, system repairs, and long-term infrastructure improvements; no action was taken.
- **Bidwell Dam Safety System:** The Board voted to **table installation of an early warning sensor system** pending revised quotes that include additional monitoring features.
- **Facility Use Agreement:** Direction was given to schedule a future special meeting to discuss a facility use agreement with the Indian Valley Recreation and Parks District.

Policy and Administrative Direction

- Staff were directed to review ordinances and policies related to **delinquent and abandoned accounts**, and a subcommittee was formed to assist in this effort.
- The Board approved direction for staff to issue a formal response to recent media coverage and share it through official District channels.

Closed Session

The Board conducted a closed session from 8:16 PM to 8:30 PM. **No reportable action was taken.**

Adjournment

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The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 PM.

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
